| Second | Institutional Contribution to the Association | Legal entities (such as institutions and companies) may contribute to the association if they meet the membership conditions. In this case, a representative of the institution shall be nominated for membership in the central association. |

| Eleventh | Founders' Privileges | Members of the association are equal in rights and duties. However, founding members who participated in establishing the association have priority over other contributors in terms of service provision. |
